



PROSPECTUS

This event is open to all artists in any medium. All items for sale must be made by you, the artist.

Registration will be on the website where you will be asked to sign up, describe your work/medium, specify whether or not you require a table, and submit payment of \$45. Please provide a photo of your work that we may use for promotion of the event. There are 30 spaces available. Exhibitors are accepted in the order of application and payment received. If we do not fill the spaces with AOY Members, registration will be opened to non-members beginning August 1, 2021.

Location of exhibitors will be determined by the Committee for an even distribution of types of artwork and all artists will be notified of their location prior to the event. Help will be available to everyone during the setup hours of 8 am to 9:30 am for carrying items from your vehicle to your location. All exhibitors will be provided a map showing designated vendor parking areas away from visitor parking. There will not be any traffic within the exhibitor areas. Your space allocation is 10' x 10' and you must be ready for business by 10 am. No tent is required. While there is some flexibility in the placement of your display, you must not intrude on fellow artists.

There is a RAIN DATE for Sunday, September 26.

AOY Art Center will not take any commission on artists' sales. Our event will have the popular Chance Raffle Table displaying a donation from each vendor with a minimum value of \$15. Donation is not mandatory, but appreciated. Raffle tickets are a good fundraiser for the Art Center with proceeds going toward capital improvements or funding Art Scholarships. We would like a small card with the Artist's name and description of the work donated. To entice visitors to sign up for our email list, there will be a door prize. All winners will be called at 3 pm.
